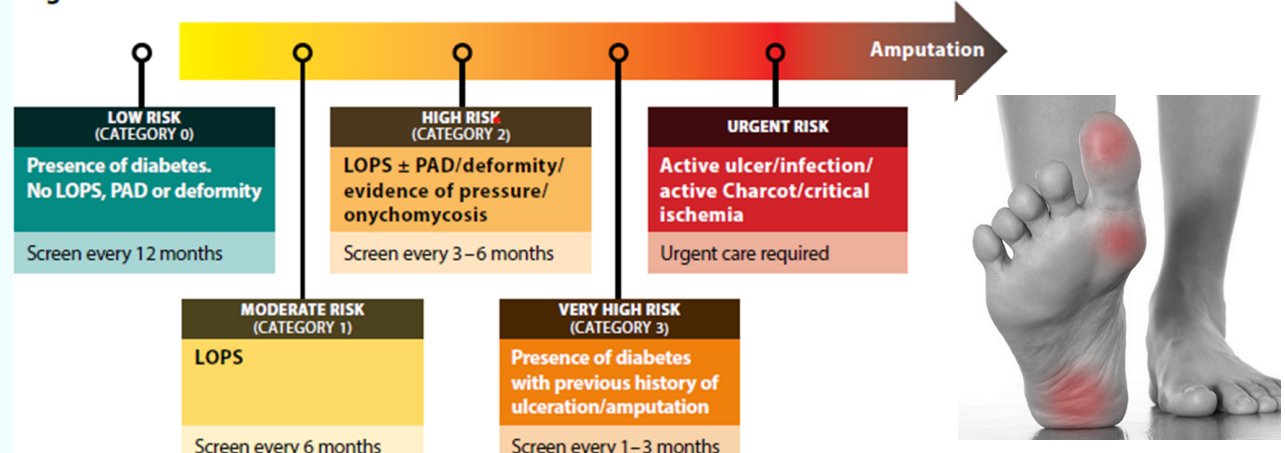
THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE LIVING WITH DIABETES IN AFRICA IS PREDICTED TO INCREASE BY

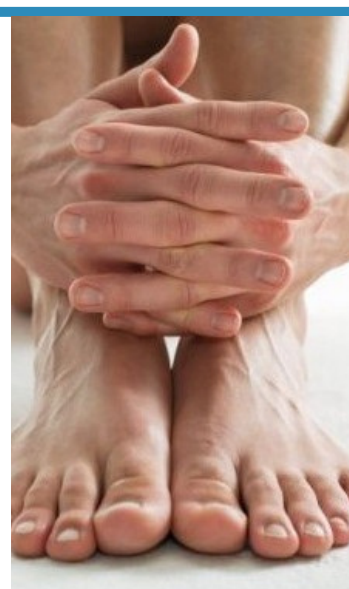


Figure 4: Risk Stratification¹⁴
